Boston Massacre	Soldiers sent to control a snowball throwing group;	<ol> <li>Some colonists killed</li> <li>British soldiers portrayed as killers</li> <li>Committees of Correspondence formed</li> <li>Colonists Unite!</li> </ol>		
Boston Tea Party	Colonists dressed as Mohawk Indians dumped tea into the Boston Harbor	<ol> <li>British tea merchants lost lots of \$</li> <li>Boston Harbor closed</li> <li>Colonists unite!</li> </ol>		

## Major Battles/Events of the American Revolution

Battles of Lexington and Concord	April, 1775 Start of Revolution; British trying to get weapons and ammunition; "Shot Heard Round the World"	<ol> <li>British didn't know the lay of the land</li> <li>British not near supplies</li> <li>Colonists hid and fired from cover</li> </ol>
Bunker Hill	June, 1775 Fought on Breed's and Bunker Hills "Don't fire until you see the whites of their eyes."	<ol> <li>British captured the hills;</li> <li>Americans killed 1,100         British     </li> <li>Gave Colonists hope</li> </ol>
Saratoga	Turning point/Climax of War; 2 battles; took a long time for British to move supplies;	<ol> <li>Colonists had time to gather</li> <li>Franklin used this win to convince France to help</li> <li>Benedict Arnold didn't get enough credit and switched sides</li> </ol>
Trenton	Christmas Night, 1776, Washington Crossed the Delaware River and surprised the Hessians	<ol> <li>Darkness made it harder to see</li> <li>Surprising after the holiday</li> <li>Surrounded the British</li> </ol>
Valley Forge	Winter 1777-1778; Cold, food low, no or poor condition shoes, diseases, worst time for Americans during war	<ol> <li>Trust for Washington grew</li> <li>Training opportunity</li> </ol>
Yorktown	Last major battle of War; the siege lasted about 20 days; Washington led the battle; Cornwalis surrendered	<ol> <li>British surrounded on a peninsula</li> <li>France came to help (troops and ships)</li> <li>The coastal plain difficult to navigate if you didn't know the area</li> </ol>
